To reconstitute add 400 c.c. sterile pyrogen-free distilled water. Intravenous saline or glucose solutions may also be used. Reconstituted plasma MUST BE DISCARDED if not used within 3 hours. Bottle No.LP203/117 This number MUST be entered on the patient's notes and quoted in any enquiry.
