

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION	A book of adhesive group B 'Whole Human Blood' group labels [number sequence B/58401 - B/58499 inclusive]. Each label page comprising six separate (by perforation) labels for labelling blood donations, samples and products (N.B.T.S. Sheffield 71).
OTHER INFORMATION	Each numbered label page/set comprises six separate labels – each with the 'B/ number' information – for labelling different material, i.e.  1. Donation Label – includes spaces for entry of 'Rhesus Group', Taken on / at and Expiry date information as well as the following information:  Contents: Whole Blood 420cc – Acid Citrate Dextrose Anticoagulant In Bottle: 120cc; In plastics Bag: 75cc Test for Compatibility before use Storage: Refrigerate at 4°C – 6°C (38° – 42°F) The contents not to be used if visible signs of deterioration  2. Name and Initials – Dry Vial Sample Label 3. Processed Donation No. – Platelets – FFP – Cryo – GG 4. Name and initials 5. Name and Initials – Male/Female Low Hb Sample 6. 'B/ number' information only Note: Adhesive on reverse of each page – many pages have adhered together over time. 'N.B.T.S. Sheffield 71' indicates that the labels were used by the 'National Blood Transfusion Service, Sheffield Blood Centre' (England).
