PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION	A glass blood bottle with an Acid Citrate Dextrose label attached. Metal screw cap with a single central hole – rubber bung underneath, together with a sample ('bijou') bottle in a metal collar. Anticoagulant is present in the blood bottle and sample bottle.
